8.15am – 8.45am £3.00 (includes breakfast)

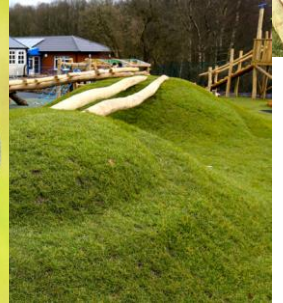
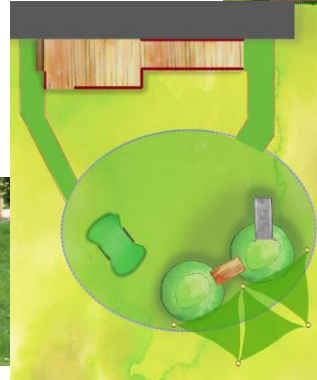
2.45pm – 4.30pm £10.50 (includes a light tea)

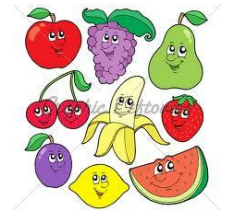


HEALTHY LUNCHES
